Clerk-Recorder Glover convened the ceremony at 9 a.m. by explaining its purpose and the procedure. (Roll call was not taken. A quorum of the Board was not present until after the swearing-in.) Rev. Bruce Henderson of the Airport Road Church of Christ gave the Invocation. Mr. Glover introduced Judge Fondi and indicated Judge Fondi had been sworn-in earlier. Judge Fondi briefly acknowledged the hard work involved with the election of the officials. He explained his pride in being selected to perform the ceremony. He indicated that both he and Judge Griffin had been sworn-in at the Courthouse earlier and explained Judge Griffin's absence. Judge Griffin had extended his regrets at not being able to attend the ceremony and congratulated all of the elected officials. Judge Fondi then conducted the swearing-in ceremony beginning with Judge Tatro and followed by the Mayor and Board of Supervisors, the Hospital Trustees, and School Trustees. Each elected official signed his/her oath of office. Upon conclusion of the ceremony Judge Fondi wished the officials success in their tenure and introduced Mayor Masayko. Mayor Masayko also welcomed the audience, congratulated the other elected officials on their election, and wished them successful terms. He thanked all for coming and invited them to partake of the refreshments. He reminded all that the regularly schedule Board meeting would be held on Thursday, January 9th. He then thanked Judge Fondi for performing the swearing-in.

There being no other matters for consideration the meeting was adjourned by mutual consent at approximately 9:15 a.m.
