Staff Summary: This grant has been awarded by the Nevada Department of Public Safety, Office of Traffic Safety and will be used to purchase hand held citation devices which are compatible with the NCATS Modernization software. These devices enable traffic crash and citation data to be electronically maintained and transmitted, thus freeing up law enforcement resources for other necessary duties while creating a valid data set to assist management in determining priorities for resource allocation.




Budget Justification: (A brief statement describing why the item(s) in the budget are needed to reach project goals and objectives.)

The equipment to be purchased with this grant is what has been recommended by the pilot agencies as well as Brazos. The MC75A is currently being used by several agencies and has been recommended as the most compatible device. Use of the older equipment listed in previous sections of this grant application would result in inefficient, ineffective, and inaccurate data collection. If we are unable to acquire the new devices personnel will be required to manually enter data by both Carson City Sheriff's Office Records Dept. and by the Carson City Municipal/Justice Courts. This is the primary reason we stopped issuing paper citations and implemented electronic citation and crash reporting.

This purchase of these devices will ensure that Carson City Sheriff's Office will be able to continue providing the state with accurate and timely data collection as well as enable patrol deputies to increase their enforcement of traffic laws thereby reducing traffic related death, injury and property damage. It will also allow us a more effective evaluation tool for determining areas of risk and areas in which to increase traffic enforcement through data collection provided by these devices.
