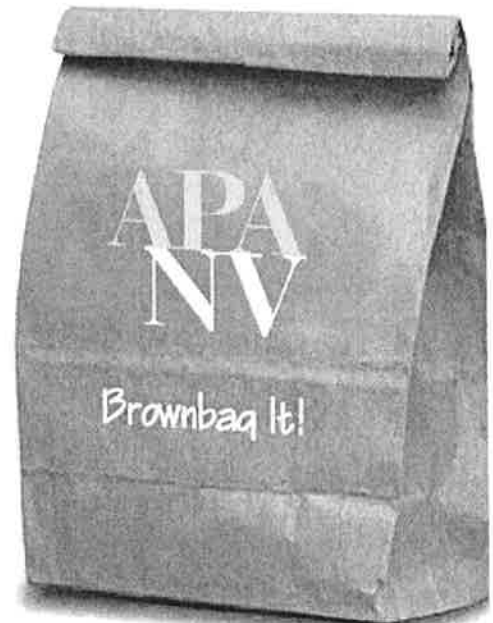

Now and Then: A Pictorial Analysis of Carson City Changes.

Mr. Jed Block, Carson City Historic Resources Commission

Mr. Block will give a presentation titled "Now and Then: A Pictorial Analysis of Carson City Changes", followed by a historic walking tour of Carson City. Mr. Block has collected numerous pictures of Carson City's Carson Street and downtown area from earlier periods, such as the 1950s and 1960s, and compares them to recently taken photos of the same locations. These comparisons reveal a lot about the history of Carson City and the colorful people who shaped its future.

Biography: Jed Block is a third generation Nevadan, born and raised in Carson City. He graduated from Carson High School and went on to earn a B.A. in Communication from the University of the Pacific in Stockton, CA. He sits on the Board of Equalization, the Carson City Cultural Commission, Vice President of the Brewery Arts Center, and fills the Carson City Chamber of Commerce seat for Redevelopment Authority Citizen Committee. He is very interested in Carson City History and would one day like to have a City Museum or a wing of the Nevada State Museum. His family owned business, State Agent and Transfer Syndicate, Inc., was formed in Carson in 1903.
