Mayor Teixeira called the meeting to order at 9:35 a.m. Roll call was not taken although the entire Board was present constituting a quorum. Rev. Bruce Henderson of the Airport Road Church of Christ gave the Invocation. Mayor Teixeira requested a moment of silence in memory of Justice of the Peace Department II-elect Bill Furlong and for the speedy recovery of Former Mayor Dan Flammer.

SWEARING-IN CEREMONIES FOR THE NEWLY ELECTED CARSON CITY OFFICIALS (1-0048) -

Mayor Teixeira corrected the program to reflect that John Anderson had been elected to serve on the School District. Mayor Teixeira noted that the City's electorate had gone against the national trend and returned a majority of the incumbents. He felt that this was an indication of the candidates' professionalism and the quality of applicants who had applied. He thanked all for offering to serve. He then introduced Judge Fondi. Judge Fondi expressed his appreciation for having been invited to participate in the swearing-in. He noted that the Justice of the Peace would be serving a six year term. He explained his opposition to the proposal to establish a limit on the terms individuals serve. He then explained the procedure and introduced the elected officials. They were: Supervisor Ward 1 Greg Smith, Supervisor Ward 3 Tom Tatro, Justice of the Peace Dept. 1 Robey Willis, District Attorney Noel Waters, Sheriff Rob Banister, Assessor Kit Weaver, Treasurer Al Kramer, Clerk-Recorder Alan Glover, Hospital Trustee District 1 Jo Saulisberry, Hospital Trustee District 5 George Hawes, School Trustee District 1 John Anderson, School Trustee District 3 Richard Demar, and School Trustee District 4 Dave Cook. The oath of office was then given. Each signed his/her official oath. Mayor Teixeira thanked all for coming and invited them to help themselves to the refreshments.

There being no other matters for consideration, the meeting was adjourned by mutual consent at approximately 10:15 a.m.
