REQUEST: Status report regarding the effects of the late November / early December rain storm on properties managed by the Open Space Program.

GENERAL DISCUSSION: At the end of November and first few days of December, the Northern Nevada region received heavy rainfall. Storm water was visibly flowing throughout the city. Several facilities were able to accommodate and retain the high flows, as designed. The attached photos show high water in Eagle Valley Creek at the Moffat Open Space Property, with water flowing over the path, into the rock-lined swale and back into the creek. The Carson River, at Deer Run Road bridge, peaked at 1,480 cfs on the morning of December 3rd.

RECOMMENDED ACTION: Status report only. No action may be taken.
