

Lompa and Hot Springs; Public Works' commitment to CQI and programs under evaluation by the teams; Communication's staffing needs; potential use of Alternative Sentencing personnel to meet some of this need; 1996 FCC requirements; increase in the Building and Safety Division's budget, permits, and inspections; utilization of and problems with the outside plan checker program; (2-1270) the need for another on-staff plan checker and (2-1485) an outside inspector; the restriction to just Carson City residents for outside plan checking; certification requirements for plan checkers; proposed fee audit; reasons for not using an outside contracted inspector; the nuisance housing inspector and his duties; current automation capabilities and needs; Vehicle Maintenance staffing needs; plans to use CQI/privatization study to evaluate Vehicle Maintenance and its needs; and use of the Capital Projects Improvement Program to fund the vehicle replacements.

(1-0212) Supervisor Bennett thanked Mr. Barker for his and his staff's cooperation in the Carson Pride and Revitalization Week activities. (1-1495) Supervisor Smith commended Parking Enforcement on the new parking limit signs in the downtown area. (1-2255) Supervisor Tatro questioned the procedures used to establish the RTC priority listing. Supervisor Smith also felt that the Board should receive the entire RTC packet in addition to the agenda and Minutes. Discussion also indicated a desire by the Board to review the listing and role in depth at another meeting. (2-0013) Mr. Homann announced Mr. Statton and (2-0495) Ms. Goddard's retirement plans. (2-1930) Supervisor Bennett indicated the nuisance housing inspector should attend the Carson Pride and Revitalization meetings. She requested periodic status reports on his work or, at the least, having the statistics included in the budget report.

(1-3488) BREAK: A five minute recess was declared at 7:30 p.m. When the meeting reconvened at 7:35 p.m. a quorum was present although Supervisor Ayres was absent as previously noted.

There being no other matters for discussion, Supervisor Bennett moved to adjourn. Mayor Teixeira seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously. Mayor Teixeira adjourned the meeting at 8:45 p.m.
