



## **Nevada Sesquicentennial Update**

Nevada's 150<sup>th</sup> anniversary of statehood kicks-off on Nevada Day 2013, October 25<sup>th</sup>. The celebration will run for a year, culminating with an expanded Nevada Day celebration on Nevada Day 2014, Friday, October 31, 2014.

In early February Governor Brian Sandoval appointed a 13-member statewide Commission to execute the plan put forth by the Sesquicentennial Planning Committee in January 2013. Members include: Neena Laxalt, A.J. "Bud" Hicks, Sherry Rupert, Bob Brown, Dr. Andy Kirk, Oscar Goodman, Randy Snow, Myron Martin, Patricia Cafferata, Lori Nelson, John Tyson, Don Newman and Chairman Lt. Governor Brian Krolicki. The Commission meets monthly in Carson City with video connections to southern Nevada.

In early actions the Commission has hired a full-time executive director, Esther Carter. Additional staff to include a community relations/events manager and administrative support staff is now being brought on. Staff is housed and operates out of the office of the Nevada Commission on Tourism in Carson City.

Highest priority is presently given to addressing fund-raising to support the budget of roughly \$3.3 million. Funds raised would go to supporting the mobile museum as well as other signature events and legacy projects yet to be endorsed.

Commission members and staff are also actively coordinating efforts with major event organizers, especially the Nevada Day, Inc., organization here in Carson City.

The Nevada Legislature has approved the design and sale of a special Nevada Sesquicentennial license plate. The plates will be available for purchase through the Department of Motor Vehicles after July 1, 2013. Proceeds from plate sales will support the Sesquicentennial efforts. Governor Sandoval is

expected to unveil the plate to the public at a press conference to be scheduled around July 1<sup>st</sup>.


*Exterior concept drawing; mobile museum*
