C. DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION REGARDING SCHEDULING OF ADDITIONAL PUBLIC HEARINGS CONCERNING THE 1993-94 FISCAL YEAR BUDGET AND OTHER RELATED MATTERS (1-1885) - Board discussion explained the need for a meeting and set May 27 at noon for final approval of the budget.

D. DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION ON THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS' GOALS AND OBJECTIVES FOR FISCAL YEAR 1993-94 (1-1970) - Mayor Teixeira stressed his desire to address the goals and objectives during the strategic planning session which should be held this fall. This would allow the tentative budget to include the Board's goals.

There being no other matters for consideration, Supervisor Tatro moved to adjourn. Supervisor Ayres seconded the motion. Motion carried 4-0. Mayor Teixeira adjourned the meeting at 7 p.m.
