A ribbon cutting ceremony to which the Carson City Board of Supervisors had been invited was held on Friday, October 23, 1992 at the Quill Water Treatment Plant, 2944 Kings Canyon Road, Carson City, NV Starting at 12:00 Noon.

RIBBON CUTTING FOR THE GRAND OPENING OF THE QUILL RANCH WATER TREATMENT PLANT - Mayor Teixeira assembled the group. Roll call was not conducted as a quorum was not present. The purpose of this meeting was to have a ribbon cutting ceremony commemorating the startup of the Quill Water Treatment Plant. Mayor Teixeira welcomed the assembled group to the plant site. He said that the facility had just been completed and asked Utility Manager Dorothy Timian-Palmer to describe the facility. She advised that the plant was built in compliance with the 1992 Safe Drinking Water Act. She added that it allows the City to use a source that had never been available before - the Ash Canyon Water Rights. She further commented that expansion capabilities had been included in the project so that when the City brings on-line the Marlette/Hobart water system or buys more surface water, the conjunctive use program could be implemented.

Watersource Consultant George Ball and Q&D Contractor Larry Klein were present. Mr. Ball, speaking on behalf of Watersource, acknowledged the work done by Project Engineer Ken Freeman and Field Inspector/Project Manager Ron Berganoni. He also complimented Q&D on its excellent construction and said an important thing is that the facility has diatomaceous filtration, which is the cutting edge of water filtration technology. The plant is the first such major facility in use in Nevada.

At this point Mayor Teixeira complimented Ms. Timian-Palmer and her staff for a job well done. He then turned the valve that started the plant.

There being no other activities programmed, the ceremony was concluded.

A tape recording of these proceedings is on file in the Clerk-Recorder's office. This tape is available for review and inspection during normal business hours. As a quorum was not present and as no action was indicated, none was taken.
