Request: Discussion only on the progress of the Downtown Business Association's mural project located at the northeast corner of Curry Street and Ann Street.

General Discussion:

On October 26, 2015, Kyle Horvath presented the Downtown Business Association's (DBA) mural project to the Cultural Commission. The Commission and City staff is in full support of this project and are very interested in receiving an update on the project's progress. As the commission knows, the mural's location is on a small wall adjacent to the north side of a City-owned parking lot at the northeast corner of Curry Street and Ann Street and on the back wall of the Bike Smith. (Refer to Pictures / Exhibits A and B). The update will include information regarding the following:

- 1) The DBA has received five applications from mural artists in the region for the project.
- 2) The DBA board has selected, based off of style of past work, the artist they would like to work with to develop the design. However, the design is NOT been discussed.
- 3) The plan is to start working on the mural during the May's wine walk.

In the future DBA representatives will have the opportunity to return at the Commission's May meeting to present the design concept, update the Commission on the project's progress, raise Community awareness about the project, and to allow the Commission and the public to address any concerns about the mural's design concept. Sharon Rosse will be present at this meeting to give the project update and to answer any questions the Commission may have about the current status of the project.
