Agenda Title: For Possible Action: To make a recommendation to the Board of Supervisors regarding funding for the “Re-Imagined Space” public art project.

Staff Summary: The Redevelopment Authority allocated \$10,000 in FY 2018 for a program to display art in vacant building spaces. Half of the available funds have been used to date, and the remaining funds are planned to be used for a project in the fall of 2018 through spring 2019. The purpose of this item is to provide an update to the RACC on the progress of the project and, if applicable, make recommendations to the Redevelopment Authority regarding the Redevelopment funding for the project.

Proposed Motion: [No action is necessary or recommended. Allow the project to be completed under current funding.]

DISCUSSION:

The Redevelopment Authority allocated \$10,000 in FY 2018 for a program to display art in vacant building spaces. The concept morphed from only using vacant interior spaces to seeking other opportunities on vacant buildings. Earlier this year, \$5,000 was spent on a project as part of the “Big Read” project, a 30-day event made possible by a National Endowment of the Arts grant to Carson City.

The remaining funds are scheduled to be used for projects with the Boys and Girls Club of Western Nevada and an outdoor vinyl window mural project. The project will be a community collaboration with artist Kindah Kalidy for lectures and workshops resulting in several outdoor vinyl artworks installed in the windows of vacant commercial properties in the Redevelopment District. The project is expected to occur in the fall of 2018 through the spring of 2019.

The Carson City Arts and Culture Director, Mark Salinas, will be available at the RACC for a presentation and questions. Attached is the presentation showing photos of the completed and proposed projects.
