Our History

- When the Boys & Girls Clubs of Western Nevada opened our doors in December 1993 we served a total of 340 kids. In 2018 our membership is 1,395 kids.
 - 5 sites including schools and the main club house – with a potential for growth
 - 3 Club sites have 100% free and reduced lunch programs
 - Average daily attendance is 418 members. 365 during the summer break
 - Average member growth per year is 15-20%
 - In 2019 we are celebrating 12 years serving youth in Carson Valley and 26 years in Carson City!



The Youth We Serve

The Boys & Girls Club fills the gap between school and home. We provide a welcoming, positive environment in which kids and teens have fun, participate in life-changing programs, and build supportive relationships with peers and caring adults.

- Everyday 1 in 4 youth in our community are left unattended after school (afterschool alliance)
- 5,275 Youth Served Annually
 - 1,395 members of the Boys & Girls Clubs of Western Nevada
 - 86% of our members are 12 & Under
 - 45% from minority populations
 - 50% qualify for free and reduced lunches
 - 46% live in single parent homes

Our Years Together

- The Carson City School District and Boys & Girls Clubs of Western Nevada have been connected since our doors opened 25 years ago, providing a number of services including busing kids to the Club every day after school, successfully providing 16 years of the 21st Century after school program and most recently becoming a pre-k site for the school district.

21st Century Community Learning Centers

4 sites currently in Carson City School District serving over 500 students

21st Century programs provides academic enrichment opportunities during non-school hours for children, particularly students who attend low-performing schools. The program helps students meet state standards in core academic subjects, such as reading and math. The program also offers students a broad array of enrichment activities that can complement their regular academic programs.

Program activities include:

- Academic activities to improve reading, math and writing grades and meet Nevada State Standards
- Enrichment activities such as games and arts & crafts
- Civics Education
- Drug and Alcohol Prevention
- STEM instruction
- Parent literacy and engagement
- Physical fitness
- Tutoring/Credit Support (Carson High School)



Pre-K Partnership

Full Day Pre-K at Boys & Girls Clubs of Western Nevada

- Partnership began 2017/2018 school year
- Pre-K has a dedicated space in a secure facility at no cost to CCSD
- The first non-academic partner that CCSD has used for a site
- Allows the school district to serve 20 additional students each year
- Helps facilitate afterschool transition from Pre-K to Kindergarten
- Acquaints parents and youth with the Boys & Girls Club and educates on our offerings and opportunities
- Daily emergency support from BGCWN Leadership Team
- This school year we are home to 20 Pre-K students, 2 para-professionals, parent volunteers and one lead teacher



Carson City Multi-Use Athletic Center (M.A.C.)

How does it fit in?

- Boys & Girls Clubs of Western Nevada holds a Joint-Use Agreement
- Partnership allows for Pre-K to use this space during the school day
- Utilized in Fall/Winter Months or when activities warrant the need for an indoor space
- Utilized for up to two recess periods each day
- Storage for Pre-K Physical Education equipment
