2.02.040 - Meetings of the board.

1. Regular meetings of the board of supervisors shall be held in Carson City on the first and third Thursdays in each calendar month, unless such day falls on a holiday or on a nonjudicial day, in which event the regular meeting shall be held on the immediately following judicial day. By a motion made in a properly noticed meeting, the board may take action to change the date of a regularly scheduled future board meeting if the board finds that it is in the best interest of the public and if the board acts to change the meeting date at least twenty (20) days before the date of the meeting to be changed.
