A meeting of the Carson City Liquor and Entertainment Board was held during the regularly scheduled Board's of Supervisors session on Thursday, January 5, 2006, at the Community Center Sierra Room, 851 East William Street, Carson City, Nevada, that began at 8:30 a.m.

Mayor Pro-Tem Williamson recessed the Board of Supervisors session and immediately convened the Liquor and Entertainment Board by noting that there was a quorum present although Chairperson Teixeira and Member Furlong were absent. A. ACTION ON APPROVAL OF MINUTES - NOVEMBER 17, 2005 (8:33:50) - Member Livermore moved to approve the Minutes of the November 17, 2005, meeting as presented. Member Aldean seconded the motion. Motion carried 4-0.

B. ACTION TO APPROVE A FULL BAR LIQUOR LICENSE FOR BILLARES LA RAZA, LLC, WITH GREGORIO AND ISABEL ARENAS AS LIQUOR MANAGERS, LOCATED AT 288 EAST WINNIE LANE (8:34:25) - Gregorio and Isabel Arenas explained their ownership of a restaurant in Reno and expansion to Carson City. Vice Chairperson Williamson pointed out the new form entitled Affidavit of Issues which the applicant had signed. (A copy is not in the Clerk's packet.) She emphasized the City/Board's concern that juveniles are not served liquor. Mr. Arenas stated that no one under 20 years old should receive alcoholic beverages. The Board corrected him to be 21. Mr. Arenas indicated that minors are not allowed in the establishment. The applicants will be running the business. Member Aldean noted the favorable Sheriff's report. Member Aldean moved to approve a Full Bar Liquor License for Billares La Raza, LLC, with Gregorio and Isabel Arenas as Liquor Managers, located at 288 East Winnie Lane; fiscal impact is \$1,000 original new fee, \$575 investigation fee; and \$200 quarterly fee. Member Livermore seconded the motion. Vice Chairperson Williamson wished them success in their new venture. Motion carried 4-0.

C. ACTION TO APPROVE THE REACTIVATION OF A PACKAGED LIQUOR LICENSE FOR 7-ELEVEN, INC., DBA 7-ELEVEN STORE #15833, WITH A CHANGE OF LIQUOR MANAGERS FROM CINDY RICHARDSON TO JIM GIRARD, LOCATED AT 3038 HIGHWAY 50 EAST (8:37:00) - Jim Girard advised that it is a corporate store which they are taking over for a few months. He is familiar with the City's Liquor Laws and will train the employees to ensure adherence with them. Member Livermore moved to approve the reactivation of a Packaged Liquor License for 7-Eleven, Inc., dba 7-Eleven Store No. 15833, with a change of Liquor Managers from Cindy Richardson to Jim Girard, located at 3038 Highway 50 East; fiscal impact is \$1,000 original new fee, \$500 investigation fee, and a \$200 quarterly fee. Member Aldean seconded the motion. Motion carried 4-0.

There being no other matters for consideration as the Liquor and Entertainment Board, Vice Chairperson Williamson adjourned the session.
