### Background/Issues & Analysis

The CCAA approved the 2020-2025 ACIP for the Carson City Airport at its May 20, 2020 meeting.

This is an annual submission of the ACIP from the CCAA to the Carson City Board of Supervisors for acceptance. The ACIP is based on the CCAA's priorities for airport maintenance and improvement. The ACIP was developed in consultation with the CCAA's consulting engineer (Armstrong Consultants) and planner (Coffman Associates).

The national ACIP is an internal FAA document that serves as the primary planning tool for identifying and prioritizing critical airport development and associated capital needs for the National Airspace System. It also serves as the basis for the distribution of annual grant funds under the Airport Improvement Program (AIP). Failure to timely submit the FAA ACIP may result in the CCAA not receiving FAA grant funding.


