1 - 3. CALL TO ORDER, ROLL CALL, AND PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

(8:29:39) – Mayor Crowell called the meeting to order at 8:29 a.m. Ms. Rowlatt called roll and noted that a quorum was present. Mayor Crowell led the Pledge of Allegiance.

4. PUBLIC COMMENT

(8:30:27) – Mayor Crowell entertained public comments; however, none were forthcoming.

5. FOR POSSIBLE ACTION: ADOPTION OF AGENDA

No changes were made to the agenda.

6. CLERK-RECORDER

6.A FOR POSSIBLE ACTION: DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION REGARDING THE CANVASS OF THE VOTE FOR THE JUNE 9, 2020, PRIMARY ELECTION.

(8:30:50) – Mayor Crowell introduced the item and suggested Ms. Rowlatt provide background information first. Ms. Rowlatt clarified that the Nevada Revised Statute (NRS) 293.387 requires the Board of Supervisors to meet with the County Clerk and canvass the returns on or before the sixth working day following the election to ensure

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“a clean election.” She also explained that candidates will have three days to initiate a recount. Mayor Crowell called this day “an important day in democracy.”

(8:32:11) – Ms. Rowlatt thanked Elections Chief Deputy Clerk Miguel Camacho and the entire elections staff, former Clerk-Recorder Sue Merriwether, election volunteers, Alternative Sentencing and Facilities (for facilitating social distancing), security staff at the Courthouse, the District Attorney’s Office, the Parks and Recreation Department, Court Administrator Max Cortes, the judges, and the Senior Center.

(8:35:10) – Ms. Rowlatt reviewed the Abstract of the Vote which was distributed to the Board members and made available to the public prior to the start of the meeting and responded to clarifying questions. Mayor Crowell thanked Ms. Rowlatt for running “an error-free, fraud-free election.” He also entertained additional comments and, when none was forthcoming, a motion.

(8:40:52) – Supervisor Bonkowski moved to accept the Canvass of the Vote for the June 9, 2020 Primary Election as presented by the Clerk-Recorder. The motion was seconded by Supervisor Barrette. Mayor Crowell entertained discussion and when none were forthcoming, a vote. Motion carried 5-0-0.

7. PUBLIC COMMENT

(8:41:34) – Mayor Crowell entertained final public comments; however, none were forthcoming.

8. FOR POSSIBLE ACTION: TO ADJOURN

(8:41:42) – Mayor Crowell adjourned the meeting at 8:41 a.m.
