**A. CALL TO ORDER**

Mr. Plemel called the meeting to order at 1:30 p.m.

**B. MODIFICATION TO THE AGENDA**

Mr. Plemel noted that there were no modifications to the agenda.

**D. PUBLIC HEARING: ACTION ITEM**

**D-1 FOR POSSIBLE ACTION: DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION REGARDING AN APPLICATION TO APPROVE A TAVERN/BAR WITH PACKAGED LIQUOR LICENSE FOR THE BANK SALOON LOCATED AT 418 SOUTH CARSON STREET, WITH RICHARD BRAGIEL AS THE LIQUOR MANAGER.**

Mr. Plemel introduced the item, and Ms. Sullivan presented an overview of the Memorandum and noted that a copy of the memo from the Carson City Sheriff's Office was included as Late Material, both of which are incorporated into the record. She mentioned that she had received an email from Brendon Gibb of the Carson City Health Department indicating that The Bank Saloon had been approved for bottled beer and wine and preparing cocktails with alcohol from approved sources. She added that The Bank Saloon site was still under construction, so as soon as the Carson City Health Department signs off on the construction portion, The Bank Saloon will be in compliance with Health Code. Furthermore, the business may not sell liquor until the Carson City Health Department has deemed the business to be built in compliance with applicable Health Codes.

The Applicant, Richard Bragiel, acknowledged that he understood and agreed to the Conditions of Approval outlined in the Memorandum and articulated by Ms. Sullivan.

**ACTION: Mr. Plemel approved the application for a Tavern/Bar with packaged liquor license for The Bank Saloon located at 418 South Carson Street, with Richard Bragiel as the Liquor Manager subject to the following Conditions of Approval:**

- All requirements of the Health Department as articulated on the record are to be Conditions of Approval.
- The applicant must sign a sworn affidavit consistent with CCMC 4.13.060 regarding a server training course.

**E. PUBLIC COMMENT**

Mr. Plemel entertained public comments; however, none were forthcoming.

**F. ADJOURNMENT**

Mr. Plemel adjourned the meeting at 1:36 p.m.
