Proposed modification to Special Use Permit U-93/94-67

We have read documents prepared by the Planning Department Staff Reports including the applicant's proposal to add playing fields to the Empire Ranch Golf Course.

We disagree with the evaluation of this proposal as a simple Amendment. It should be considered a New Proposed Use based on the following:

- The proposed use is a substantial increase from passive, low intensity golf to high intensity active use team sports (soccer, lacrosse) competitive team practice, play, and tournaments.
 - Golf participant density is less than 8 players per group where soccer or lacrosse teams could average 30 players plus coaches, etc per roster. Double that by adding in family spectators and support personnel. A simple local game could average 100 persons at one field of use.
- Morgan Mill Road barely accommodates the safe passage of two passenger vehicles next to each other near the proposed amended use area.
- The land in the proposed amended use area is a low zone where the Carson River over flows at flood stage and becomes easily saturated from rain and snow which is probably why it is undesirable for golf use.
- Soils along much of the Carson River may contain mercury from the Comstock mining mills. Disturbance could elevate exposure to these risks.
 - Mediation could require substantial soil replacement and / or overlays to mitigate player safety and vehicle road / parking stability.
- The remote location of the proposed fields would need additional human sanitation and trash management.
 - The nearest facility is the river access put-in / take-out and picnic area. This site alone would be easily overwhelmed and detracting to river cleanliness.

We support the concerns (traffic, trash, over-head lighting and noise impacts, etc.) submitted by other residents in adjacent neighborhoods. This proposed use is a significant change in use which would be degrading to current lifestyles and property values that attracted residential use here and has supported golf, bicycle, and walking trail uses.

Rather than repeat the well-stated issues and facts written by our neighbors, we support and echo their concerns and opposition. Their research raises numerous questions that should be answered prior to jeopardizing Carson City's Quality of Life emphasis.

Please put the current residents (neighbors and Carson City in general) first and reconsider rushing to make an immediate yet potentially temporary change.

If the need for playing fields in Carson City is in such a high demand, then it should be put to the citizens, businesses and Open Space Committee to recommend and evaluate highest and best use sites throughout the greater Carson City area.

We are residents of the Empire Ranch Subdivision, and we are concerned about the development plans for the Empire Ranch Golf Course. The proposed soccer practice area was supposed to be two small fields in the northwest corner of the property, with parking for about 25 cars off Morgan Mill Rd.

Now we find that the proposed plan is much bigger, and will be "lit by high-powered LEDs that maximize facility utilization". This is in direct opposition to the original proposal for low-powered, ground-directed lighting. We don't want to live across from something that looks like Greater Nevada Field.

We are also concerned for traffic along Morgan Mill Road. The Engineering Division's report stated: "The application included a proposal for unpaved parking off Morgan Mill Road. No traffic impact study submitted. There is insufficient information to determine that the project will have little or no detrimental impact to vehicular and pedestrian traffic."

We find it difficult to believe that it WON'T have a detriment impact to vehicular and pedestrian traffic." Right now, it's difficult to walk along Morgan Mill Road when two cars pass in opposite directions. Particularly if you're walking a dog, as many do in this area. This just seems like an accident waiting to happen.

The meeting material published on-line references several studies to be completed regarding various impacts. Have these studies been completed? If not, discussion of approval for this proposal seems premature at this time.
