Greetings:

I am writing to express my thoughts on a proposed grant application for a Complete Streets project on William Street.

Short version: HARD NO!

More detailed version: Complete Streets is a program that diverts resources away from the most popular mode of transportation in favor of unpopular modes of transportation. The result is increased traffic congestion, longer travel times, and increased frustration for motorists. These negatives are not proportional to the positives gained by pedestrians and cyclists, as the inclusion of wider sidewalks and the addition of bicycle lanes results in little or no increase in pedestrian and cycle traffic. For examples, I'll point to the recent Complete Streets project on South Carson Street. A multi-use path was added which sits mostly unused. Motor vehicle traffic was squeezed from three lanes down to two, and speed limits were reduced. This has not helped anyone. I would also like to point out that William Street presently has sidewalks along its full length, as well as cycle paths which are mostly unused. Please do not do anything to William Street.

If you want to spend some money to help pedestrians in Carson City, why don't you try finishing the sidewalks in neighborhoods where they're incomplete? If I walk from my house on Moody Street up to a store on North Carson, I invariably end up walking in the street because the sidewalks are half missing on most streets in my neighborhood.
