1. CALL TO ORDER

(5:30:25) – Chairperson Drews called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.

3. PUBLIC COMMENT

(5:31:01) – Chairperson Drews entertained public comments. Darrin Berger introduced himself. He apologized for “the last-minute nature” of having agenda item 5.B pulled from the agenda and stated that he was looking forward to speaking with the Commissioners at the next HRC meeting.

4. FOR POSSIBLE ACTION: APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES FROM MARCH 9, 2023.

(5:31:56) – Chairperson Drews introduced the item and entertained a motion to approve the minutes of the March 9, 2023 meeting as presented.

(5:32:09) – **MOTION: Commissioner Block so moved. Commissioner Wright seconded the motion. The motion carried 6-0-0.**

5. MEETING ITEMS

5.A HRC-2023-0224 FOR POSSIBLE ACTION: DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION REGARDING A RECOMMENDATION TO THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS FOR A REQUEST FROM JEFFREY K SULLIVAN AND JULIE E HOUE (“APPLICANTS”) FOR A HISTORIC TAX DEFERMENT ON HISTORIC RESOURCES COMMISSION PAGE 2 JULY 13, 2023 PROPERTY ZONED RESIDENTIAL OFFICE (“RO”), LOCATED AT 308 N. NEVADA STREET, ASSESSOR’S PARCEL NUMBER (“APN”) 003-227-03.

(5:32:25) – Chairperson Drews introduced the item. Ms. Sullivan referenced the Staff Report and the accompanying attachments, all of which are incorporated into the record. She also responded to clarifying questions.

(5:33:48) – In response to Commissioner Block’s inquiry about whether the rear building “fits in” with the square footage for the Historical Tax Deferral, Ms. Sullivan indicated that the Commissioners could phrase the motion to recommend approval for the Historical Tax Deferral for the primary residence only. Based on Commissioner Speulda’s comment, Ms. Sullivan stated that the Commissioners could do an exclusion if they believed the rear building did not contribute to the rest of the property.

(5:37:22) – Chairperson Drews entertained public comments and, when none were forthcoming, a motion.

(5:37:35) – **MOTION: Commissioner Wright moved to recommend to the Board of Supervisors approval of HRC-2023-0224, excluding the rear building, based on the finding that the request is consistent with the design guidelines for the Historic District and the Secretary of the Interior Standards as noted in the Staff Report. Vice Chairperson Schmitter seconded the motion. The motion carried 6-0-0.**

5.B HRC-2023-0218 FOR POSSIBLE ACTION: DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION REGARDING A REQUEST BY THE FIRST PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH (“APPLICANT”) FOR A NEW READER BOARD SIGN ON PROPERTY ZONED RESIDENTIAL OFFICE (“RO”), LOCATED AT 115 N. DIVISION STREET, ASSESSOR’S PARCEL NUMBER (“APN”) 003-214-07.

He also noted that he read an article about the property located on Fourth Street and Division Street and how the aluminum siding was pulled off the side of the building in the 1970s to restore the original siding currently attached to the building.

(5:42:19) – In response to Vice Chairperson Schmitter’s question, Ms. Sullivan confirmed that she, Vice Chairperson Schmitter, and Chairperson Drews were still members of the National Alliance of Preservation Commissions (NAPC) and offered to provide the date for the next NAPC conference. Vice Chairperson Schmitter requested that Ms. Sullivan ensure that she, Vice Chairperson Schmitter, and Chairperson Drews were receiving emails from the NAPC.
