Background/Issues & Analysis

The former Recreation Program Supervisor-Arts and Culture, Sierra Scott resigned at the end of May. After a rigorous job recruitment, the position has been filled by Anna Freeman.

The South Carson Street Roundabout project is moving forward; 153 applicants were received. Nine panelists were selected and scored each application. Three finalists were selected and notified. All three finalists have accepted their call for phase two of the selection process and are in the process of making the required visit to Carson City to see the project site.

The Murals and Music Festival is scheduled for September 28-30, 2023. Twenty-one mural sites are being identified and assigned to the artists. Artists are working on draft designs. They will each complete a mural over the course of the weekend of the event.
