Project Proposal

- Perform maintenance on a ¼ mile segment of Bob's Trail, located in the Ash Canyon area. Maintenance will include:
- 'Brushing' to clear overgrown vegetation blocking the trail and improve line-of-sight.
- Widen the trail for easier hiking and bike riding, and add room to pass.
- Remove large rocks and roots from the trail tread for added safety.
- Fill any holes, for safety.


Why?
