A meeting of the Carson City Growth Management Commission was held during a regularly scheduled meeting of the Carson City Planning Commission on Wednesday, March 26, 2003, at the Community Center Sierra Room, 851 East William Street, Carson City, Nevada, beginning at 3:30 p.m.

Chairperson Wipfli convened the Growth Management Commission. Roll call was taken. A quorum was present although Member Christianson was absent. GM-02/03-2 - ACTION ON APPROVAL OF WATER USAGE REQUEST FROM RIBEIRO CORPORATION (1-0960) - Community Development Director Walter Sullivan explained staff's request for a continuance. Commissioner Peery moved to continue GM-02/03-2 until City staff reviews the applicant's information and can provide the Growth Management Commission with a recommendation. Commissioner Kimbrough seconded the motion. Mountain West Engineer and Ribeiro Representative Cary Chisum agreed to the continuance. The motion was voted and carried 5-0.

Chairperson Wipfli adjourned the Growth Management Commission and immediately reconvened the Planning Commission.
