CAMP STORE

Camp Carson offers a Camp Store to purchase camper shirts and other camper apparel. The camp store will open on May 5. Camp shirts will cost \$10.00 plus tax/per shirt (through Colossal Printing Company) and parents can pick up shirts at the Community Center at a later date. Camp Shirts may be ordered at the time of registration or after, but shirts will not be able to be purchased through the Camp Store via Colossal Printing Company after June 3. If you are not able to purchase a shirt by June 3 then you may purchase Camper shirts at the Community Center. Shirts will be \$15/per shirt at the Community Center. We strongly recommend that parents purchase camper shirts by June 3 to get the best rate.

- **Camp Carson Program:**
Kindergarten–6th Grade
June 16–August 8
- **Registration opens May 5 for Weeks 1–4 and June 2 for Weeks 5–8**
- **Price Per Child/Per Week: \$125**
- **Optional Field Trip Per Week: \$30**
- **Optional Swimming Lessons—\$44/Per 2 Weeks (Monday–Thursday)**
- **Camper T-shirts: \$10.00 plus tax or \$15.00/Per Shirt and are required for all campers.**
- **Camp Hours are from 7:00am–6:00pm Monday through Friday. No Camp on 6/19 and 7/4.**
- **Camp Sessions are weekly. No daily rates.**
- **Payment is due at the time of registration.**
- **There is NO payment plan option for Camp.**
- **Unenrollment for weeks that have been purchased, must occur by 4:00pm, the Wednesday prior, for a refund.**
- **Additional Field Trips MUST be registered & paid for online or at the Carson Aquatic Facility.**
- **Unenrollment from field trips must occur by 4:00pm, the Wednesday of the same week, for a refund.**
- **No same day registration for camp or field trips.**
- **Camp Carson has included one Open Swim day a week.**
