CAPITAL KIDS BEFORE & AFTER SCHOOL PROGRAM

Carson City's Parks and Recreation holds a before and after-school recreational enrichment program for children in Kindergarten through 5th grade called Capital Kids. The program is held at Carson City public elementary schools and observes the School District holiday calendar. The program is designed to provide children with creative structure while their parents work. Recreational activities such as arts & crafts, sports, games, enrichment programs, STEAM, special events, and homework assistance provide the basis of the program. Programs are licensed by Nevada Child Care Licensing.

PLEASE NOTE: There will be NO refunds given for time that is paid for and was not attended.



CAPITAL KIDS BEFORE SCHOOL PROGRAM

The Before-School Program is held in the Gym of the Carson City Community Center. Participants are bussed to school from the Community Center by the Carson City School District. Children will not arrive in time for the breakfast program at school. There are no before school offerings for Montessori participants. All participants must be dropped off NO later than 7:30am to be on time for the bus. Before-School Program participants are eligible for Professional Learning and Non-School Days. There will be NO credit given for holidays or days missed. ENROLLMENT IS LIMITED! Hours are from 6:30am-8:00am



CAPITAL KIDS AFTER SCHOOL PROGRAM

The After-School Program is held in the multi-purpose rooms of Bordewich, Fritsch, and Seeliger elementary schools. Depending on the enrollment numbers, one or more schools may be transported to another school to create a larger group. Parents of those schools will be informed prior to the start of each school year. There is no After School Program for Montessori and Empire. Children attending Fremont and Mark Twain will be transported in Bordewich.

Hours are from 3:15pm-6:00pm.

There will be NO extra charge for Professional Learning and Non-School Days when you attend the Before & After-School Program. There will be NO credit given for holidays or days missed.

PLEASE NOTE: A \$15 late fee will be assessed beginning at 6:01pm for every 15 minutes your child is picked up late.
