1. I understand that I have been charged with a battery which constitutes domestic violence, in violation of NRS 33.018, 200.481, and 200.485/Carson City Municipal Code 8.44.020

2. This is an offense which has the following elements:

- A battery, which is a harmful or offensive application of force or violence upon the person of another; and
- Committed against or upon a spouse, former spouse, person to whom the Defendant is related by blood or marriage, except a sibling or cousin who is not in a custodial or guardian relationship with the Defendant, a person with whom the Defendant resides or has resided, a person with whom the Defendant has had or has a dating relationship, a person with whom the Defendant has a child in common, or a minor child of any person described above; and
- This occurred on or about (date) \_\_\_\_\_, 20\_\_\_\_, in Carson City, Nevada.

PENALTIES AND RIGHTS:

3. I understand the State must prove the above elements of the crime beyond a reasonable doubt.

4. I understand the following possible punishments:

**1<sup>st</sup> OFFENSE** in 7 years - A minimum of 2 days, but not more than 6 months in Jail; a minimum of 48 hours, but not more than 120 hours of community service; a fee of \$35; a fine of not less than \$200, but not more than \$1,000; and successful completion of counseling at the Defendant's own expense with weekly sessions of not less than 1 ½ hours per week for at least 6 months in a State-certified program for the treatment of persons who commit domestic violence.

**2<sup>nd</sup> OFFENSE** in 7 years - A minimum of 20 days, but not more than 6 months in Jail; a minimum of 100 hours, but not more than 200 hours of community service; a fee of \$35; a fine of not less than \$500, but not more than \$1,000; and successful completion of counseling at the Defendant's own expense with weekly sessions of not less than 1 ½ hours per week for at least 12 months in a State-certified program for the treatment of persons who commit domestic violence.

**3<sup>rd</sup> OFFENSE** in 7 years - At least 1 year, but not more than 6 years in the Nevada State Prison and a fine of not less than \$1,000, but not more than \$5,000.

5. I understand the State may use this and any other constitutionally valid prior conviction of any battery which constitutes domestic violence to enhance the penalty for any subsequent battery which constituted domestic violence.

6. I understand I have the right to have an attorney represent me.

7. I understand there are significant dangers and disadvantages to representing myself and the assistance of an attorney can be very valuable in evaluating the facts, applying the law, presenting my evidence, and challenging the State's evidence.

1 \_\_\_\_\_ 8. I understand if I cannot afford an attorney, the Court will appoint one to represent me.  
2 \_\_\_\_\_ I give up this right to an attorney; OR

4 \_\_\_\_\_ 9. I understand that if I am convicted of a misdemeanor or felony that constitutes domestic violence  
5 pursuant to NRS 33.018, my possession, shipment, transportation, or receipt of a firearm or ammunition  
6 may constitute a felony pursuant to NRS 202.360 or 18 U.S.C. § 922(g)(9)  
7 \_\_\_\_\_ 10. I understand I have the right to a speedy and public trial in front of a Judge and I give up this right.  
8 \_\_\_\_\_ 11. I understand I have the right to confront and question all witnesses against me and I give up this right.  
9 \_\_\_\_\_ 12. I understand I have the right to subpoena witnesses on my behalf and compel their attendance and I  
10 give up this right.  
11 \_\_\_\_\_ 13. I understand if I plead guilty now, I have the right to a reasonable delay before sentencing.  
12 \_\_\_\_\_ 14. I understand I have the right to a reasonable delay before entering a plea to the charge in this case.  
13 \_\_\_\_\_ 15. I understand I have the right to remain silent and not to incriminate myself and I give up this right.  
14 \_\_\_\_\_ 16. I understand probation and suspended sentences are not available for any of the above minimum  
15 mandatory sentences, and the Judge is not bound by any agreement between the parties.  
16 \_\_\_\_\_ 17. I am voluntarily pleading:  
17 \_\_\_\_\_ Guilty to the offense as stated in the first paragraph without any promise of leniency or threats  
18 having been made because I am, in fact, guilty of this offense.  
19 \_\_\_\_\_ Nolo Contendere (No Contest) to the offense as stated in the first paragraph without any promise of  
20 leniency or threats having been made because it is in my best interest to do so.  
21 \_\_\_\_\_ 18. I further acknowledge that I have been advised that if I am not a United States citizen, conviction of  
22 this offense can result in deportation, revocation of resident alien status, visa or work permit, denial of re-admission  
23 to the United States, and denial of naturalization should I apply.
