

RESOLUTION NO. 2025-R-22

**A RESOLUTION TO DISCONTINUE THE REDEVELOPMENT
AUTHORITY CITIZENS COMMITTEE AS A FORMAL ADVISORY
BOARD OF CARSON CITY.**

WHEREAS, in 1993, the Carson City Redevelopment Authority and the Board of Supervisors adopted Resolution No. 1993RAR-2 and 1993-R-22, which together created a "Citizen's Committee" now formally known as the Redevelopment Authority Citizens Committee for the purpose of reviewing developer requests for City-issued incentives that facilitate public benefits derived from proposed projects, including the stimulation of economic development, and to make recommendations on Redevelopment Area Plans, incentive programs, special event funding and other matters pertaining to the Redevelopment District and within the authority of the Redevelopment Authority; and

WHEREAS, the Carson City Board of Supervisors and Redevelopment Authority have determined that incentive programs for small, private redevelopment projects are no longer necessary or financially sustainable and therefore it is proper to discontinue the Redevelopment Authority Citizens Committee as a formal advisory board of Carson City;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of Supervisors hereby resolves to discontinue the Carson City Redevelopment Authority Citizens Committee effectively immediately upon adoption of this resolution.
