

RESOLUTION NO. 2025-R-27

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DISBURSEMENT OF COMMUNITY SUPPORT SERVICES GRANT FUNDS TO NON-PROFIT ORGANIZATIONS FOR FISCAL YEAR ("FY") 2025-2026

WHEREAS, NRS 244.1505(1) provides the Board of Supervisors may grant money to private, not for profit organizations; and

WHEREAS, NRS 244.1505(3) provides that such grants must be made by a resolution which specifies the purpose of the grant, the maximum amount to be expended from the grant, and any other conditions upon the expenditure; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors has approved the expenditure of funds for community support services grants, the City has received applications for those grant funds, and the Board of Supervisors has determined that the disbursement of the grants to the private, not for profit organizations that are listed below will give a substantial benefit to the inhabitants of Carson City;

NOW, THEREFORE THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS RESOLVES THAT:
