**ORDER FOR BRIEFING SCHEDULE**

On November 26, 2025, Petitioner filed a Petition for Judicial Review. Petitioner must  
serve the Petition for Judicial Review upon the agency and every party within 45 days after the  
filing of the Petition for Judicial Review. NRS 233B.130(5).

1 The agency and any party desiring to participate in the judicial review must file and serve  
2 a statement of intent to participate within 20 days after service of the Petition for Judicial  
3 Review. NRS 233B.130(3).

4 Within 45 days after service of the Petition for Judicial Review, the Petitioner shall  
5 transmit to this Court an original or certified copy of the transcript of evidence resulting in the  
6 final decision of the agency, and the agency that rendered the decision which is the subject of the  
7 petition shall transmit to this Court the original or a certified copy of the remainder of the record  
8 of the proceeding under review. NRS 233B.131(1). "The record may be shortened by  
9 stipulation of the parties to the proceeding." *Id.*

10 Petitioners must file and serve an Opening Brief (memorandum of points and authorities)  
11 within 40 days after the agency has given written notice that the record has been filed with the  
12 Court. NRS 233B.133(1). Petitioners' failure to file an Opening Brief within the time limitation  
13 shall be deemed an admission the appeal was not well founded and shall constitute adequate  
14 cause for dismissal of this action.

15 Respondents shall file and serve an Answering Brief (memorandum of points and  
16 authorities) within 30 days after service of Petitioners' Opening Brief. NRS 233B.133(2).  
17 Petitioner may file and serve and Reply Brief (memorandum of points and authorities) within 30  
18 days after service of Respondent's Answering Brief. NRS 233B.133(3). Either party shall file a  
19 request for submission once the appeal is fully briefed to bring the matter to this Court's  
20 attention.

21 Any party may request a hearing within 7 days after expiration of the time within which  
22 Petitioners are required to file a Reply Brief. NRS 233B.133(4). The grant or denial of a  
23 hearing shall lie within the Court's discretion. Rule 3.12 FJDCR.
