ORDER FOR HEARING ON PETITION

Petitioner filed its Petition for Writ of Mandamus on August 15, 2025. The Petition seeks an order directing Respondent to provide Petitioner with documents pursuant to the Nevada Public Records Act (NPR) in Chapter 239 of the Nevada Revised Statutes. This matter was initially submitted to the Court for decision on September 30, 2025, however, Respondent's opposition to the Petition was then filed on October 17, 2025. Petitioner then filed its reply in support of the Petition on October 24, 2025. The matter was not re-submitted to the Court for review, but the Court is aware that this matter is a priority as set forth in NRS 239.011(2).¹ A Joint Request for Status Check was filed on January 23, 2026.

¹The NPR) requires the Court to "give this matter priority over other civil matters to which priority is not given by other statutes," NRS 239.011(2). Unfortunately, this Court has numerous matters which are subject to priority and has made every effort to expedite this matter as well.


1 After a full and careful review of the pleadings and the exhibits attached thereto,
2 this Court believes that a hearing is needed, rather than a status check, for the Court to
3 have a complete understanding of the public records requests and responses and the
4 application of the Public Records Law to this case. There were numerous document
5 requests made by Petitioner, responses provided, requests were modified, redacted
6 documents were provided, and more responses between the Parties.

7 Therefore, based upon the foregoing and good cause appearing, a hearing is
8 scheduled to address whether the Petition for Writ of Mandamus should issue on
9 **Friday, February 6, 2026, at 9:30 a.m.**

10 The Parties may submit a hearing statement, if desired, ten (10) judicial days
11 prior to the hearing with service to the other party.
